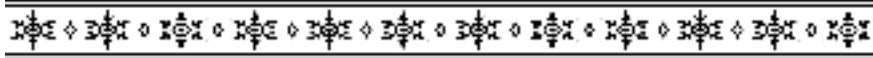

Samaritan's Purse Canada and Christian Reformed World Relief Committee-Disaster Response Service have teamed up to help the flood victims in Zealand and Burtt's Corner. Over 100 homes along the Keswick River have been damaged and need immediate attention to prevent mould from developing.

Work will start with volunteers on **Tuesday, Dec. 28, 2010** meeting daily at the Burtt's Corner Baptist Church (base camp) at 8:30 am. Volunteers will be assigned to homes where they will work until about 4 pm with a break at noon for a warm lunch at the Burtt's Corner Baptist Church. This will continue until all work is completed in the area. Your help for one or more days is greatly appreciated.
